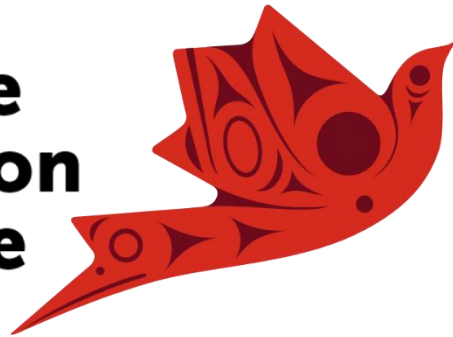

Purpose

This bundle provides resources about gender and gender identity for innovators, to support you along your journey to create safer and more gender-affirming spaces within your projects and communities.
